## INTRODUCTION.

THE compilation of this Register would have been an impossible task if Old Walton Lodgers had not given their assistance by supplying information, not only as to themselves, but also as to other members of their families and their friends. To all such thanks are duly tendered.

The Register is divided into two parts. Part I consists so far as the name G. R. Ainslie (307) of a copy of the three framed lists which used to hang over the fireplace in the big schoolroom. The largest of these lists contains the names of some who were educated by Stephen Cornish's father and brother at Compton Dando and elsewhere, as also at Walton Lodge; this list was written by J. C. V. Mather (114). The two other framed lists are by other hands, and have the dates inserted. When the names from the framed lists cease, a careful comparison has been made of the School Lists printed at the end of each term, and the names of new boys are placed under the term in which their names appear for the first time.

Part II is arranged in alphabetical order, with a reference number to Part I, and contains the full name, the Public School, and present address, or the date of death, if these details are known. It is hoped that by giving the Public School; the details of the boy's after-career could be traced and so avoid the expense of reprinting what could be read either in the register of that Public School or in the various books of reference.

The Register only deals with those who were under Cornish, but may serve as an example for a further Register which will, no doubt, contain as many, if not more, names of those who have truly and wisely served God both in Church and State.
